VISION STATEMENT**

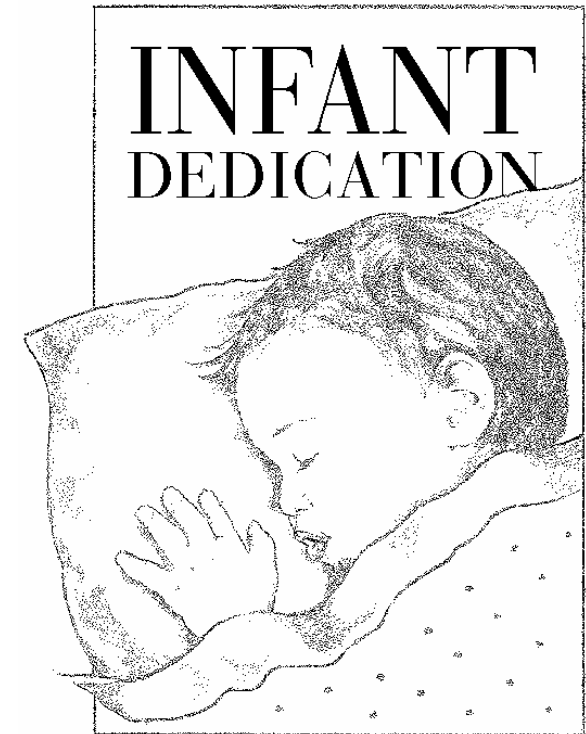
