Roof and Remodeling Project. At our Church Business meeting last Fall, you, the church members, voted to apply to the Pacific Union Conference for a \$250,000 loan to reroof the church building and make repairs to the outside and inside of the building. In other words, to bring the building back to its original like new condition. The loan has been approved and funds are now available to draw on. We are currently seeking bids from commercial roofers with the hope of starting the reroofing phase in June. The monthly loan payment will be \$2215. This is in addition to the monthly operating budget of \$7027. The first loan payment will be due the month following the first draw against the loan, which is expected to be July.
