Health Nugget

In a study done on 10 generations of quail chicks in Japan comparing GMO and non-GMO diets it was found: “Even though some differences were found among the feeding groups, none could be judged as a negative influence of GM maize or GM soya in feed on the birds or final consumer products over 10 generations of Japanese quails.” The study was done using 8,438 quail chicks.
