Health Nugget

Animal products, including eggs, dairy, meat, and animal protein in general, increase inflammation. A single meal of meat, eggs, or dairy can cause a spike of inflammation that within hours can stiffen one’s arteries. Several factors account for this effect, including heme iron, endotoxins, saturated fat, high bacterial load, TMAO, tapeworms, Advanced Glycation End products (AGEs), and NeuGc, a foreign meat protein that can increase the risk of heart disease and cancer.
