Health Nugget

Flax is the #1 whole-food source of <u>lignans</u> with 800 times more lignans than any other food. The <u>phytonutrient</u> is associated with prolonged survival in cancer patients, especially <u>breast cancer</u>. Flax seeds may be beneficial in suppressing the growth of breast and <u>prostate cancers</u> because when consumed, tumor cell proliferation drops, and cancer cell death increases. Combining flax with dietary fat restriction may have an even greater effect on prostate cancer. Moreover, eating only one tablespoon of ground flaxseed daily may also help prevent and reverse diabetes.
