Health Nugget

A 27-year study done in Sweden on poor breakfast habits in adolescence related to odds of future metabolic syndrome concluded that: Poor breakfast habits in adolescence (defined as skipping breakfast or only eating or drinking something sweet.) predicted the metabolic syndrome in adulthood. Specifically, poor breakfast habits in adolescence predicted central obesity and high fasting glucose in adulthood. *Ref.
